



Changing The View Selection For Analyzing

This is a supplemental piece for modifying the selection view when analyzing. Please review "Analyzing a Project" for more complete instructions.


1. First, to see how the Browser Organization is set up, open the project in Revit and select the 'View' tab.



2. Click on 'User Interface' on the far right side, then select 'Browser Organization'.



3. The Browser Organization pop up window will open. There are two tabs in Browser Organization: one for Views and one for Sheets. Select the 'Edit' on the 'Views' tab.




Next the 'Browser Organization Properties' will open and you will see how the project has its Browser set for Views. See the example below:


Grouped by: Working or Printed

Then by: Type


Then by: Drawing Classification Folder



4. Back in Openings Studio, if you want the 'View Selection' to look the same as the the 'Browser Organization' set in Revit, you can set it in the 'View Ordering' and 'Sheet Ordering' tabs when analyzing.



The Openings Studio 'View Selection' will now show the Floor Plans and Sheets in the same order as the Project Browser in Revit. This will analyze into Openings Studio with the same names as well.
